Latour Capital strengthens its team thanks to the arrival of a new Senior Partner with international experience



Latour Capital welcomes Jean-François Beaudoin as a Senior Partner. Jean-François will bring his operational experience, at the heart of Latour Capital's strategy, as a former senior executive of several major CAC 40 industrial companies. A graduate of École Polytechnique and holding a PhD in mathematics from Mines ParisTech, Jean-François began his career in 2001 in the Innovation Department of the Stellantis group (then PSA-Peugeot Citroën), where he headed the aerodynamics research teams. He joined Alstom's transport branch in 2007, where he held successive management positions in the Technical, Operations and Finance departments, before moving to Asia in 2014, and becoming shortly afterwards Alstom's President for the Asia-Pacific Region. During his 4 years tenure in the region, he successfully developed Alstom's presence in these markets, making it one of the leaders in Asia. He tripled operational capacities through

an ambitious localization policy in China, India and Australia. In particular, he made India Alstom's largest engineering center in the world, turning the country into a hub to serve both the fast-developing local market and international demand. Returning to France in 2018, Jean-François became the global head of the Digital Mobility product line, which in 2021, following the acquisition of Bombardier Transportation, was re-organized into the Digital & Integrated Systems branch, grouping together digital signaling & solutions, infrastructure, and turnkey projects (18,000 employees in 50+ countries, €4.5b sales). Jean-François turned this product line into the main vector for the digitalization of Alstom's solutions portfolio.

Over the course of his career, Jean-François has developed a solid experience in the international development of technological and industrial activities, at ease both as a leader of large-scale operations and as a decisive decision-maker to operate profitability turnarounds. Jean-François furthermore led a number of mergers and acquisitions, both at small (\sim 5m) and very large (>1b) scale, with a strong focus on integration strategy, development and post-acquisition value creation.
